Module 1: Aerial Photography - Entering the World Above

1. Your First Assignment

1. Capture three different photographs with your drone
2. Choose your favorite and post it to [our private Facebook community](#)

4. Write down one thing that you like about the photo and one thing that you think could improve

2. TLC - The Formula for Great Shots

1. From your archive, find at least 3 photos that you think have the three elements of TLC

5. Golden Hour Aerials

1. Capture at least 5 photographs of a landscape or cityscape during the golden hour. Paying close attention to how the light affects the scene as golden hour progresses

3. Explain why you chose this one over the others in the description and note down the TLC elements that make the image work and write how your photo applies each element of the TLC formula

6. Expanding the View - 180° Panoramic Photos

1. Capture at least three 180 panoramas using your drone, remember to get close enough to your subject or point of interest so it's prominent on the frame in the final photo

7. The Human Element

1. Capture a landscape without a person and, using the same composition, include a person for a second photograph

4. Post the photo without a person in the comments for people to see the difference

7. Don't Let That Shot Miss You!

Then, if you ever revisited the location in better conditions you can use those images or even better, if you have the chance to revisit it in better conditions capture the image that you had intended in the first place
